## Projects

1. Upgrade on Kubota is complete. Ken Weskamp undertook this work and paid for the majority of it. The department did purchase a new alternator, two tires, and re-deployed several wildland tools to the unit. This vehicle is now being used for routine patrols of the GRRRFD environment to complement those done by Chief Sprow.
2. Medical upgrade. Multiple materials have been acquired to upgrade department medical capabilities to those compatible with the services provided by an EMT-Basic with all endorsements. The next step is training review of the above and advancement to Advanced Life Support capability.
3. Your Heart Matters. Pit Crew CPR training occurs quarterly. Periodic refreshers with LifePak-12 for medical personnel are being performed.
4. AFG Grant. The confined space training is done. RIT training is next, joint with Manhattan. The MSA G-1 SCBA units are ordered. Masks and the RIT unit are at the dealer. All will be delivered when complete and mask fitting will be done.
5. Vehicle inspections. Monthly vehicle inspection compliance has been suboptimal since January. Inspections will now be done on the morning of the first Saturday of each month as a group effort. We anticipate much better performance. **DOT inspections of E-11, T-11, W-11, and QRU-11 are recommended if the Board agrees. We need Board input on this.**
